Using the information below, create a bar graph that compares animal sizes. Then identify each animal as a mammal, reptile, amphibian, fish, or insect. Which group of animals tends to be the largest? Which tends to be the smallest? Does size affect their winter behavior?

Caterpillar:	1 inch	Woodchuck:	24 inches
Bluegill:	10 inches	Chipmunk:	10 inches
Carp:	15 inches	Beaver:	46 inches
Snake:	24 inches	Ladybug:	0.25 inch
Butterfly:	3 inches	Waterboatman:	1 inch
