Create a see-saw book to compare two different frogs.

For example, on the first left-hand page, you might write:

“Western toads lay their eggs in long strings.”

On the facing right-hand page, they could write:

“Wood frogs lay their eggs in clusters.”

The next page would read:

“Both kinds of frogs lay their eggs in the water.”

The rest of the pages in the book should continue to compare the two frogs.

You can include information about their sizes, foods, predators, habitats, and more.
