



Size Matters

Using the information below, create a bar graph that compares the sizes of different frogs. Then practice drawing the frogs to scale.

You may want to color the frogs using A Place for *Frogs* as a guide.

- Green frog 3 inches
  Northern leopard frog 4 inches
  Wood frog 2 inches
  Pine barrens tree frog 1 inch
- California red-legged frog 5 inches

## **Doing More**

- A frog's tongue is about one-third the length of its body. If your tongue was that long, you could use it to clean out your belly button! Using the sizes listed above, calculate the length of each frog's tongue.
- Most frogs can jump about twenty times their body length. Using the sizes listed above, calculate how far each species can jump.
