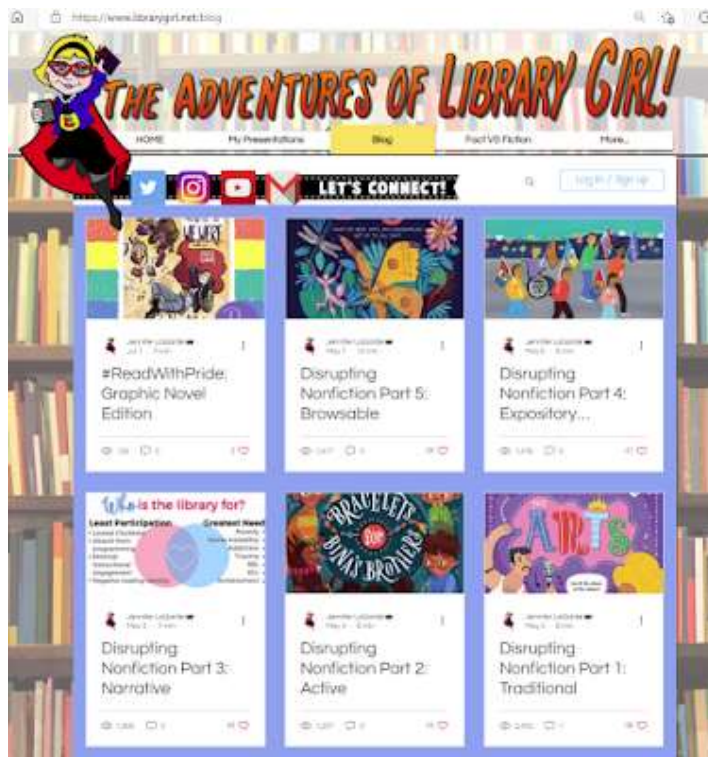


Combing the 5 Kinds of Nonfiction and #DisruptTexts
