Create a see-saw book to compare two different frogs. For example, on the first left-hand page, you might write:

“American toads have bumpy gray skin.”

On the facing right-hand page, you could write:

““Northern leopard frogs have smooth green skin with spots.”

The next page could read:

“Both kinds of frogs can breathe through their skin.”

The rest of the pages in the book should continue to compare the two frogs. You can include information about their sizes, foods, predators, habitats, and more. You may want to use a web to help organize your thoughts.
